What is NCLC?

National Chiropractic Legislative Conference

The conference is held annually in Washington DC and is expected to host a record 400+ Chiropractic students from all over North America. We lobby with legislators to pass healthcare legislation that includes and utilizes Chiropractic.

Previous victories include the implementation of a full-scope Medicare Demonstration project, the establishment of permanent Chiropractic benefits for Active-Duty military and military veterans, and the inclusion of Chiropractic in National Healthcare reform plans. Standard Process Scholarships
